Professor Chris Whitty has been appointed as the new Chief Medical Officer (CMO) for England, and the UK Government's Chief Medical Adviser from October 2019. He is currently the Chief Scientific Adviser for the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC), a practising NHS Consultant Physician in acute medicine and infectious diseases at University College London Hospitals (UCLH), and Gresham Professor of Physic..

Professor Whitty's lecture is timely given the development of the new Kent and Medway Medical School and the establishment of the new NIHR Applied Research Collaboration Kent, Surrey and Sussex which both have a specific focus on addressing community health needs and improving health and social care services across the region.
