

EARLY CAREER RESEARCH STAFF

This prize recognises the excellence of members of our research community.

Criteria:

Members of staff can make nominations for the Early Career Research Staff Prize. Nominations must be supported by evidence of the nominee's excellent achievements and commitment to their research and the research community. Self-nominations are also accepted.

Nominations will be either (i) based on a number of excellent achievements across a range of areas which may include (but are not limited to) some of those listed below or (ii) one particularly outstanding achievement in one area only. The application should outline the basis on which it is to be considered.

The nomination must be accompanied by a statement of support from either:

- Head of School/Division/Principal Investigator or
- the nominator (if there is one)

Outputs e.g. publications, grants and conference papers

Impact: this might include public engagement activities e.g. talks or exhibitions or engagement with non-higher education institutions e.g. placements/internships.

Leadership and academic citizenship e.g. helping others, mentoring (formal or informal), community-building activities beyond your own research project.

Eligibility:

This award is only open to those staff who are Postdocs, Research Associates or Assistants or other staff conducting research who are not on substantive contracts.
