Whitstable Biennale is a festival of contemporary visual art. We focus on commissioning ambitious and experimental new work, in film and performance. The next Whitstable Biennale will take place 31st May – 15th June 2014. www.whitstablebiennale.com

Whitstable Biennale **seeks new student film works** made by current students or those who have graduated within the previous two years, from:

- University of the Creative Arts (Canterbury),
- Canterbury Christ Church,
- School of Arts at University of Kent (Canterbury and Medway),

Film submissions must be no more than 5 minutes in length, or a 5 min excerpt of a longer piece. The original work can be of any length. The film will be screened using a digital projector, and therefore needs to be submitted as a digital file or on DVD.

Up to six films will be selected by our specialist team of curators. Have a look at the developing [online archive](#) on our website to see the type of work we have commissioned in the past.

Selected films will be screened at a special public event on Friday 13th June 2014 held during the Whitstable Biennale.

Deadline

All submissions must be received by **5p.m on Friday 28th February 2014**

Submission requirements

We can accept film submissions via file share link, online video / URL, or on DVD by post.

Please note we will need to receive **both** the film submission and an online application for your submission to be eligible.

If you are posting your submission, please ensure you include the title of the work and your full name with your DVD.
